Home Learning opportunities should be used to engage and enthuse children to learn independently and with their family. This overview has been formed in consultation with parents, children & teachers. Core Knowledge projects are carefully planned to allow children to develop their own interest in a subject and to feed directly in to class learning. We aim to allow children to have choices when developing a Core Knowledge project.

The table below is a guide to how much homework is given:
